A sunny sports day- who would have thought it! Thankyou to everyone for their support, cheering and enjoyment throughout this afternoon. The pupils were fantastic - especially the effort, the smiles and general sportsmanship and support for all. Thank you also to FoOMS for supporting the event and to Mr Morrow for all his hard work in setting up.

Next week we have our Year 5 and 6 Summer Concert. It will be an evening to showcase the talents of our wonderful musicians with guest appearances from the orchestra, choir and handbell group. St Peter's and St Paul's Church, 6pm start.

We are also beginning our transition process in earnest. Transition works on 3 levels - years 2-3, years 6-7, and then in-school transition for year groups already at OMS. Our Year 2 into 3 transition has already begun, for example, with the small feeder schools having taster sessions at OMS. Year 6 to 7 have a range of transition experiences including spending time at Ousedale getting used to the school. For in-school transition, although we have our main transition days on 3rd and 4th July, where children will spend two days with their new teacher, lots of work is already taking place behind the scenes; new class teachers are spending lots of time working with the current teacher, and will work for short amounts of time with their new class. The process is about ensuring that every child is settled and ready for next year, and also giving the teacher all the knowledge needed to ensure optimum progress of every child. I will send a letter out early next week with all the class teachers for 2018/19.
