To gain this award, you need to complete three tasks and bring them to me for marking/discussion.

Task One - Geographical enquiry

This is an investigation into a feature of physical geography that you are interested in (tornadoes, earthquakes, extreme weather are just some ideas), including all the stages:

- Stage 1: Introduction and planning.
- Stage 2: Fieldwork
- Stage 3: Data presentation
- Stage 4: Analysing data
- Stage 5: Conclusions/Evaluation.

You can present this in any way you choose but must be prepared to discuss your understanding of this geography with me after you hand it in.

Task Two - Local study

Tell me all about your local area! Research/explore the area and present your findings precisely and clearly. Your presentation must provide clear understanding of the area you pick using precise geographical vocabulary.

This could be an A3 poster, a PowerPoint presentation, a leaflet... The choice is yours. You must:

- include physical geography
- include human geography
- use/display maps
- use/display photographs/images
- collect/find/use data.

Task Three - research and answer this question:

What is the importance of Climate Change to the children of today?

Please present your findings in the form of an inspirational poster to be displayed around school, explaining Climate Change to your peers and what they can do to help our Earth.
