Writing MASTER Task

Do you have what it takes to be a Writing Master?

Do you have a way with words and a talent for story telling?

To achieve your Writing Master qualification, you will need to complete two written tasks based on your favourite book or book series. These will then be judged in line with the writing expectations of your year group.

Task 1

A piece of fiction based on the story. This could be an alternative final chapter, retelling a chapter from a different character's perspective, or turning the tide on the mood of a story (for example re-writing a happy, cheery chapter in a sinister, eerie way).

Task 2

A piece of non-fiction also linked to the same book or book series. There are lots of different types of non-fiction you could choose. Some are listed below:

- Newspaper report
- Diary entry
- Non-chronological report
- Persuasive argument
- Balanced argument
- Biography
- Letter
- Speech.

Both tasks will need to be submitted to Miss Henderson. You will be given feedback with suggestions to improve your writing further before your Master is awarded to you.
